Our goal is to create a balanced assessment system that is purposeful yet not overwhelming to students and teachers. We strive to motivate, inspire and celebrate.

Challenges in 2011

- Low NECAP Scores
- Poor school culture
- Poor image in the Newport community
- Highest % in RI of students sent to private schools
- 80 phone calls to the police in 2010

In 2014...

Over three years, TMS school-wide NECAP scores have improved:

- 18% in reading proficiency
- 9% in mathematics proficiency
- 13% in writing proficiency

Last year's 8th graders were the highest performing group in TMS history. 8th grade reading proficiency was **87**%.

Other achievements...

- TMS has cut truancy by over 50%.
- TMS has enrolled over 40 students who have chosen to leave private/parochial schools.
- TMS has been highlighted in the local newspaper over 20 times.
